Minutes

The Town of Champion Planning Board meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Peter LaBarge. Attending were members James Surace, Frank Koster, Kathryn Smith, and Zoning Enforcement Officer Brian Phelps. Frances Brooks was excused.

The minutes from the meeting June 22, 2004, were read. Peter LaBarge made a motion to accept the minutes and Jim Surace seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

A public hearing for a proposed minor subdivision by the LaFontaine Family Trust on the Switzer Road was held. No one spoke for or against the proposal. Jim Surace made a motion seconded by Peter LaBarge to approve the subdivision. The motion passed unanimously.

A public hearing for a proposed minor subdivision of 44.9 acres on the Jackson II road by James Parker was held. No one spoke for or against the subdivision. Peter LaBarge made a motion to approve the subdivision. Frank Koster seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

John Greene submitted an application for a minor subdivision of approximately 94 acres at the intersection of Pennock Road and County Rte 143. The motion to accept the negative declaration on the environmental assessment was made by Jim Surace and seconded by Peter LaBarge. A motion to hold a public hearing was made by Peter LaBarge and seconded by Frank Koster. The public hearing will be held at 7:30 p.m., Tuesday, July 27, 2004. Mr. Greene was instructed to pay the required fee to the Town Clerk and bring the receipt to the next meeting.

Kathleen Riches-Amyot left two maps for perusal by the board. The Pedestrian Trail map depicts walkways in the Carthage-West Carthage area utilizing existing sidewalks when possible for snowmobiling, skiing, walking, etc. The second, designated Black River Blueway Trail, was accompanied by a handout itemizing completed, current and planned projects by community and state.
